“STRONGER TOGETHER”

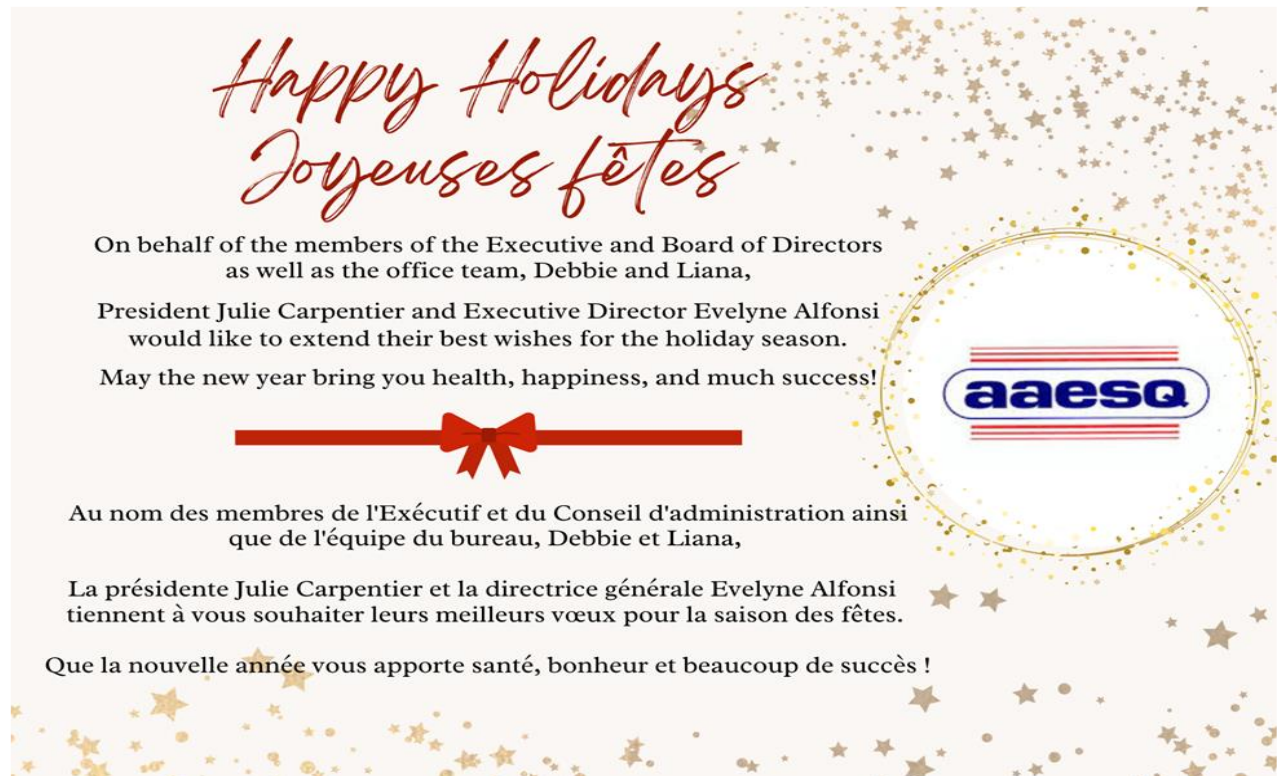
