SSQ has recently decided on the following actions for those who are pregnant or persons accompanying them who may be travelling or about to travel. If you are one who may be affected, it is imperative that you communicate with SSQ.

Required documentation to complete any file for reimbursement if your trip or insurance was purchased before February 1, 2016;

- a signed medical certificate indicating that the person is pregnant
- proof that your destination is a risk factor
- proof that your airline has refused to reimburse

Subsequently, SSQ will review your claim.
